Lot 33 is now up to date in assessments. There are eight fall assessments due (3 ½ months behind), two are expected, and two are in bankruptcy. Receipts are down about \$5K from this time last year; it is estimated \$2.9K is not collectable with about \$1.7K probably recoverable. Eric Weidl to contact those behind in assessment payments.

Discussed about writing off the non-collectable debt (Lot 55; now three years and Lot 76; in foreclosure.)

Eric will present the financial statement with last year's data for comparison.

2012 Budget TBD next month. About 65% goes toward landscaping. Budget would need to include finishing the bylaws. The Board would like a management firm for assistance but in light of a 4-5K shortfall, we might have to increase the yearly assessment. The amounts discussed varied from \$50- \$100/ year.

The Board reviewed the February 12, 2012 financial statement. **Motion to accept report by Polek with a second by Kohlfeld, with unanimous approval by the board.**

Receive last bill from Tallgrass for \$1900 which was witin the alloted budget for completion of the swale work rocks blanket. Project completed.

#### Subdivision dead tree removal and replacement.

Twelve of the 14 affected trees have been removed and area restoration completed by Efrain. Joe Miller will take the lead on removal of the two trees (off Old Farm and Denker Ct.)

**Bonfire area condition** – will wait to spring to review.
